



How do I get to the Carlos Museum?

1



Park in the Oxford Rd. Parking Deck.

Locate a building entrance.

Take the elevator to Level 3.

Exit the Emory Office of Admissions.




Go towards the Boisfeuillet Jones Center.

Take a right turn, following the accessibility markers.





Take a sharp left when you reach the end of the building.



Turn right at the stairs and locate the Information Booth.



Continue following the red brick path towards the Information Booth.



Go around the Information Booth.

Continue following the accessibility markers.

Cross the road, turn left, and continue down the red brick path.

Please beware of oncoming traffic.

Cross the road once again and take a sharp right turn.

You will pass a small lot which offers additional accessible parking spaces.

Parking here is available for non-Emory visitors **weekdays after 4:00 PM** and **all day Saturday and Sunday**.

A government issued hangtag must be displayed at all times.

Continue forward along the sidewalk and you will reach the Carlos Museum's accessible entrance.

Visitors may also be dropped off and picked up in this area.
